Joli Jug, gave me nearly 2 decades of pleasure. I'm 82. Ability to maintain and enjoy are declining. Jug needs a new skipper to enjoy, maintain & improve her as much or more than I did.

## **Engine**

Original 61 HP Ford Lehman 4-cylinder diesel. Rebuilt before January 2004 when I bought & brought

Jug from the Chesapeake Bay to the Hudson River's fresh water. Engine has never let me down. Hour gauge now reads 1,774.8 hours.



#### **Forward Cabin**

Headliner removed, ceiling faired and painted. Stainless water-tight port holes. Galley sink w/space for induction burner near existing 120V outlet.

120V A/C w/heat pump.

Dining table leg now being replaced. (Table drops to support two-person bunk).



### Head

Manual Jabsco, pump replaced in 2023. Ten gallon holding tank. Stand up shower can be installed using existing drain on the floor just below bottom right corner of photo.





## **Pilot House & Cockpit**

View ahead from co-pilot's seat

Raised pilot-copilot seat improves vision and allows opening of engine hatch. White oak post: strengthens the ceiling, supports the pilot seat & mast, and makes space for a handhold (at top of post) and a fire extinguisher.

Large shelf keeps VHF and ChartPlotter/ECHOMAP close to pilot & copilot.

Starboard & port cushioned benches, with crawl-in size lazarettes below.

12VDC/120VAC cooler/freezer fits under pilot seat in front of starboard bench.

Benches seat 4 at folding tables (folding tables not included).

Sunbrella enclosed w/vinyl windows & screens.



Aft Cabin Sitting headroom for two. Starboard and port quarter berths <u>or</u> single nearly queen-size berth. Cushions match forward cabin. Four built-in drawers. Port holes: 4 original (need replacing) & 1 stern port light. (Headliner should be removed.) More lazarettes.

**Stern Swim Platform** Swing ladder down to swim, up to step up from platform to main deck.

#### Main Deck

Original stainless rails around bow and stern.

Handholds on top of: pilot house, forward & aft cabins. Two anchors, one rode with depth tags. Four 8" diameter fenders. Mast for loading bicycle (bike, rack, and lift boom not included).

#### Miscellaneous

Two 30Amp shore power cables. Required distress signals, day & night. One gallon oil-change pump. One wrench/tool set. For winter storage: 6 jack stands, 6"x6" & 4"x6" blocks, reusable tarp frame. Tarp may have 1 more winter in it.
